Town of South Hampton Selectmen's Ordinances

DISORDERLY CONDUCT

Adopted June 30, 1983

IT SHALL BE UNLAWFUL:

- 1. FOR TWO OR MORE PERSONS TO LOITER, ASSEMBLE, OR CONGREGATE ON ANY PUBLIC WAY TOWN-OWNED PROPERTY, OR IN ANY PUBLIC PLACE IN THE TOWN OF SOUTH HAMPTON, THEREBY IMPEDING, OR TO THE ANNOYANCE OF ANY PERSON;
- 2. FOR ANY PERSON TO REMAIN UPON ANY PUBLIC WAY OR TOWN-OWNED PROPERTY, OR IN ANY PUBLIC PLACE AS SPECIFIED IN 1., ABOVE, AFTER BEING ORDERED BY A POLICE OFFICER TO MOVE ON.

ANY VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BE DEEMED TO BE DISORDERLY CONDUCT, AND SHALL BE PUNISHABLE BY A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN FIFTY DOLLARS (\$50.00)

THIS ORDINANCE SHALL TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY AFTER PUBLICATION IN A LOCAL NEWSPAPER AND SHALL BE POSTED IN TWO PUBLIC PLACES WITHIN THE TOWN OF SOUTH HAMPTON.
