

**Town of South Hampton  
Selectmen's Ordinances**

***OPEN CONTAINER***

Adopted June 30, 1983

IT SHALL BE UNLAWFUL FOR ANY PERSON:

1. TO CONSUME ANY ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE, OR TO HAVE IN HIS OR HER POSSESSION ANY OPEN CONTAINER OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE WHILE UPON ANY PUBLIC PARK, PLAYGROUND, SIDEWALK, COMMON OR ANY PUBLIC HIGHWAY OR ANY TOWN-OWNED PROPERTY WITHIN THE TOWN LIMITS OF SOUTH HAMPTON;
2. TO CONSUME ANY ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE, OR TO HAVE IN HIS OR HER POSSESSION ANY OPEN CONTAINER OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE WHILE IN ANY VEHICLE WHILE UPON ANY PUBLIC PARK, PLAYGROUND, SIDEWALK, COMMON OR ANY PUBLIC HIGHWAY, OR ANY TOWN-OWNED PROPERTY WITHIN THE TOWN LIMITS OF SOUTH HAMPTON.

ANY VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BE PUNISHABLE BY A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00)

Exceptions to the provisions of this ordinance may be granted by permission of the Board of Selectmen and/or the Chief of Police of the Town of South Hampton. Application for special permits must be made in writing no less than 15 days prior to the scheduled event.

THIS ORDINANCE SHALL TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY AFTER PUBLICATION IN A LOCAL NEWSPAPER AND SHALL BE POSTED IN TWO PUBLIC PLACES WITHIN THE TOWN OF SOUTH HAMPTON.
